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Research on the Path of Inheriting Excellent Traditional Chinese Culture in Ideological and Political Education in Colleges and Universities

Later, sub-columns related to students' feedback can be set up. This way is not only conducive to establishing a connection between students and the columns, enhancing the stickiness between them, but also can stimulate and sustain students' enthusiasm for learning and inheriting fine traditional Chinese culture. By guiding them to read the contents continuously, it helps improve their cognitive level and recognition of the culture.

3.3. Strengthen curriculum construction to give play to the educational function of culture

For college students to better learn and inherit the culture, they should take the ideological and political classroom as the main channel, pay attention to the infiltration of the culture, and through infiltrating it into the whole process of ideological and political education, put the cultivation of students' values in a prominent position.
